## Program Summary

This was followed by **Dr. Harikumar Pallathadka**, Hon'ble Chancellor of MIU deliver the keynote address to the august gathering and sharing the activities and program MIU is working on to build a better platform for academic excellence for the people of the state.

**Dr. Rajiv Kangabam, Manager BRTC, KIIT TBI** shared the overview and objective of Manipur Technology Innovation Hub (MTI-Hub) highlighting the importance of Technology Business Incubator in the state of Manipur. Dr. Kangabam also brief about the Role of KIIT TBI and BCKIC in supporting the startups. He also shares about the facilities and infrastructures MTI HUB is going to provide for the startup ecosystem. He also elaborated the participants about the funding opportunities for Innovation & Entrepreneurship provided by various government agencies such from ideation to commercialization such as Social Innovation Immersion Program, DST NIDHI- Entrepreneurs-in-Residence (EIR), DST NIDHI-PRAYAS, Meity Tide 2.0, Biotechnology Ignition Grant, Innovation for Defence Excellence, MSME-BI, ARISE ANIC, Promoting Innovations in Individuals, Start-ups and MSMEs (PRISM), Small Business Innovation Research Initiative (SBIRI), Biotechnology Industry Partnership Programme (BIPP), Atal New India Challenge, SEED (SUSTAINABLE ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT) Fund, LEAP (Launching Entrepreneurial Driven Affordable Products) Fund, BIOTECHNOLOGY INNOVATION Fund –AcE (ACCELERATING ENTREPRENEURS FUND), National Science & Technology Entrepreneurship Development Board (NSTEDB) - Seed Support System, Technology

Development Board (TDB) - Seed Support System, Promoting Academic Research Conversion to Enterprise (PACE), Start-up Research Grant (SRG), Core Research Grant, Scientific and Useful Profound Research Advancement (SUPRA), Industry Relevant R&D. Dr. Kangabam also shared list of Grand Challenges Topic to all the participants to work out innovative ideas and solutions. A problem statement for the NE region provided the DONER secretary was also shared with the participants to come up with the solutions.

**Mr. Malay Mohapatra, Program Manager MTI-Hub** spoke on facilities available at Manipur Technology Innovation Hub such as Incubation Space, Ideation Lab, Design and Prototyping Facilities, Testing and Validation Center, Central Lab Facility, Office Space. Mr. Mohapatra highlighted the facilities available like 3D Printing, 3D Scanning, PCB Fabrication, CNC Vertical Milling, CNC Router, CNC Laser Engraver, Vinyl Cutter, Advance Electronics System, Wood Work Facility, Digital Health Facility. He also shared with the participants about the software facilities provided to the startups, prototypes developed, Startups leveraging Fab lab, programs conducted for startups, and training and workshop organized.

**An elevator pitch session** was conducted among the selected participations and the following participation share their idea.

- 1) **Dr. Sushmita Thokchom** - Removal of pesticides residue from vegetables (Brinjal)
- 2) **Moirangthem Nipamacha Singh**- Popularizing Yoga among the guardians of Tuition goers
- 3) **Andy Yadav** - Use of modern technology in Agriculture Sector
- 4) **Thokchom Priya Devi**- Creating social mindset among the people

**Prof. T. Brajeshwari Devi, Registrar** of MIU talked about how to write grants for funding Innovative ideas to the participants.
